

# AEIOU BE AWESOME FOR AUTISM 2024 RAFFLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms and conditions of entry.
2. To be eligible to enter, this raffle is open to all current supporters, new supporters, family and friends of AEIOU Foundation, staff and directors of AEIOU Foundation and the public.
3. Entrants must complete the form online via the AEIOU Foundation Raffle website by completing their contact details in the section provided.
4. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be ineligible. Complete entries will include at least a first name and surname, an email address and/or telephone number at a minimum.
5. Entrants are not restricted or limited to the number of raffle tickets which may be purchased.
6. Raffle tickets sales will commence on 23/04/2024 AEST and conclude on 28/04/2024 10.55am AEST. Raffle will be drawn on 28/04/2024 11am.
7. Entrants need to be present to win. Prize cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash.
8. The draw for the winner will take place at the AEIOU Brisbane Fun Run & Family Day at University of Queensland, All Abilities playground on the main stage. If the winners are under the age of 18 years the prizes will be awarded to their parents or legal guardians.
9. In the draw for the winner, the 1st prize will be drawn first and the other prizes (if applicable) drawn in descending order of the prize number and value.
10. The AEIOU Foundation reserves the right to request winners to submit their ticket receipt as proof of identity and purchase. Proof of identification of entry considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the AEIOU Foundation.
